Scott Sheafe was born in California, but spent much of his early life in Fairfax County, Virginia where he graduated from W.T. Woodson High School in 1988. Scott chose to attend the University of Arizona in an effort to experience an academic culture different than that of the East Coast. He graduated with a degree in Public Administration in 1992.

During his time at the University of Arizona, Brother Sheafe served as the Beta Phi Chapter's Annotator and Magister. Scott also held an internship position with the Pima County Attorney's Office where he assisted the investigative team in preparing for trials and provided support services to victims of violent crime.

Scott was sworn in as a Special Agent of the United States Secret Service in December of 1992. During his tenure, Scott held several leadership positions within the Secret Service including assignments in the Washington Field Office, the Presidential Protective Division, the Boston Field Office, the Dignitary Protective Division and Secret Service Headquarters.

Brother Sheafe was awarded multiple commendations during his time as a Special Agent for both his investigative and protective accomplishments. Upon leaving the Secret Service, Scott became the Global Security Director for Mars, Incorporated where he is responsible for the wellbeing of 70,000 employees and 130 manufacturing facilities located in over 70 countries.

Scott is active in his local community where he serves as a volunteer for the Chantilly Youth Association and remains committed to the efforts of Reston Bible Church. He married Catherine Mattox Surles (Beta Phi Sweetheart '92) in September of 1993.

Of his Sigma Chi experience, Brother Sheafe stated: "The Brothers of the Beta Phi Chapter of Sigma Chi served as my family when I was separated by thousands of miles from my own. As a result of the relationships that started at Beta Phi and the sacred bond that has grown stronger over time, I know that there are men all over this world that I can turn to in times of need who will never fail me."
